ACB = Agricultural Credit Bank. The ACB in the table above contains a Farm Credit Bank subsidiary. An ACB has the authority to serve cooperatives nationwide and affiliated ACAs and FLCAs within its chartered territory.

FCB = Farm Credit Bank. An FCB has the authority to serve affiliated ACAs and FLCAs within its chartered territory.
